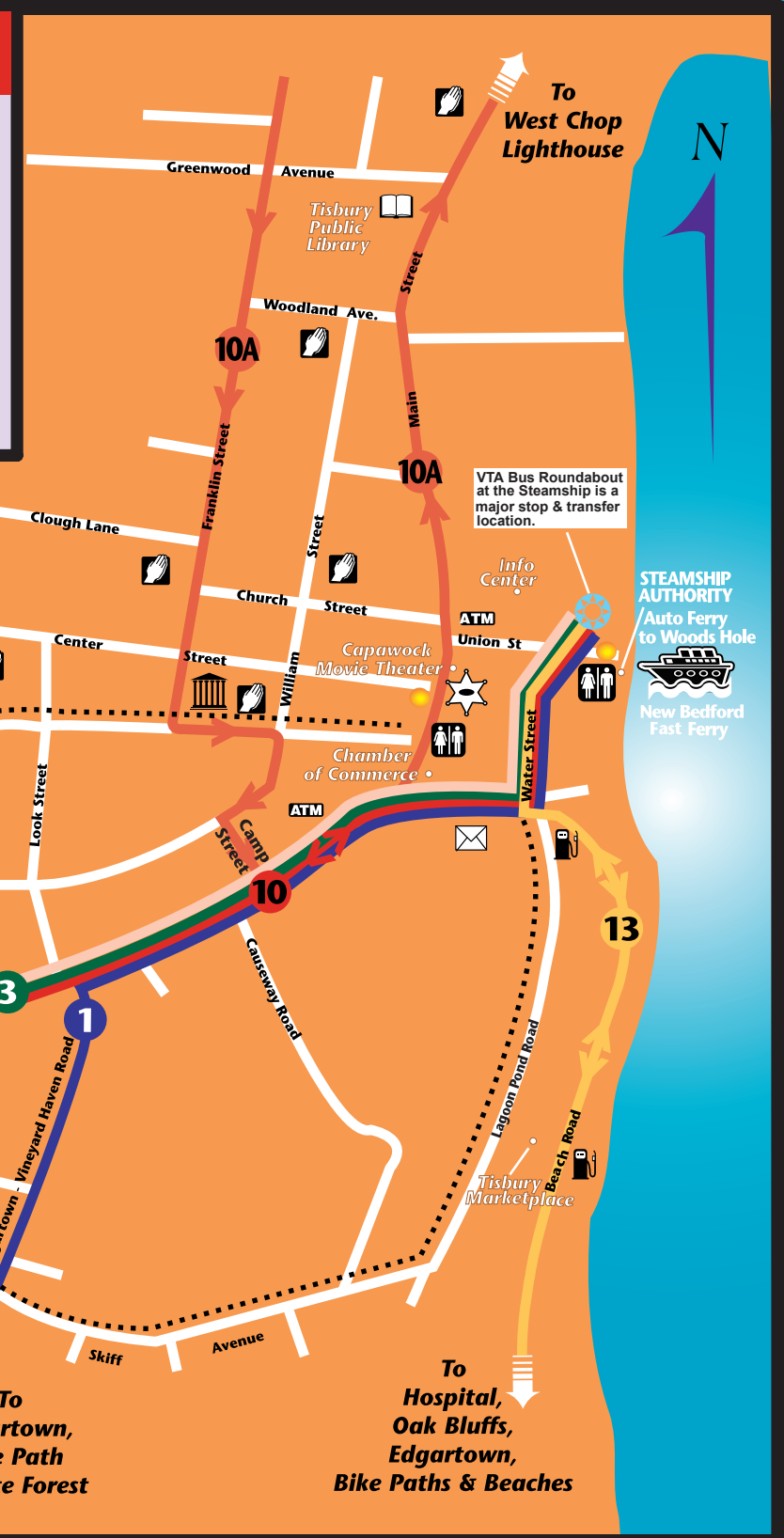
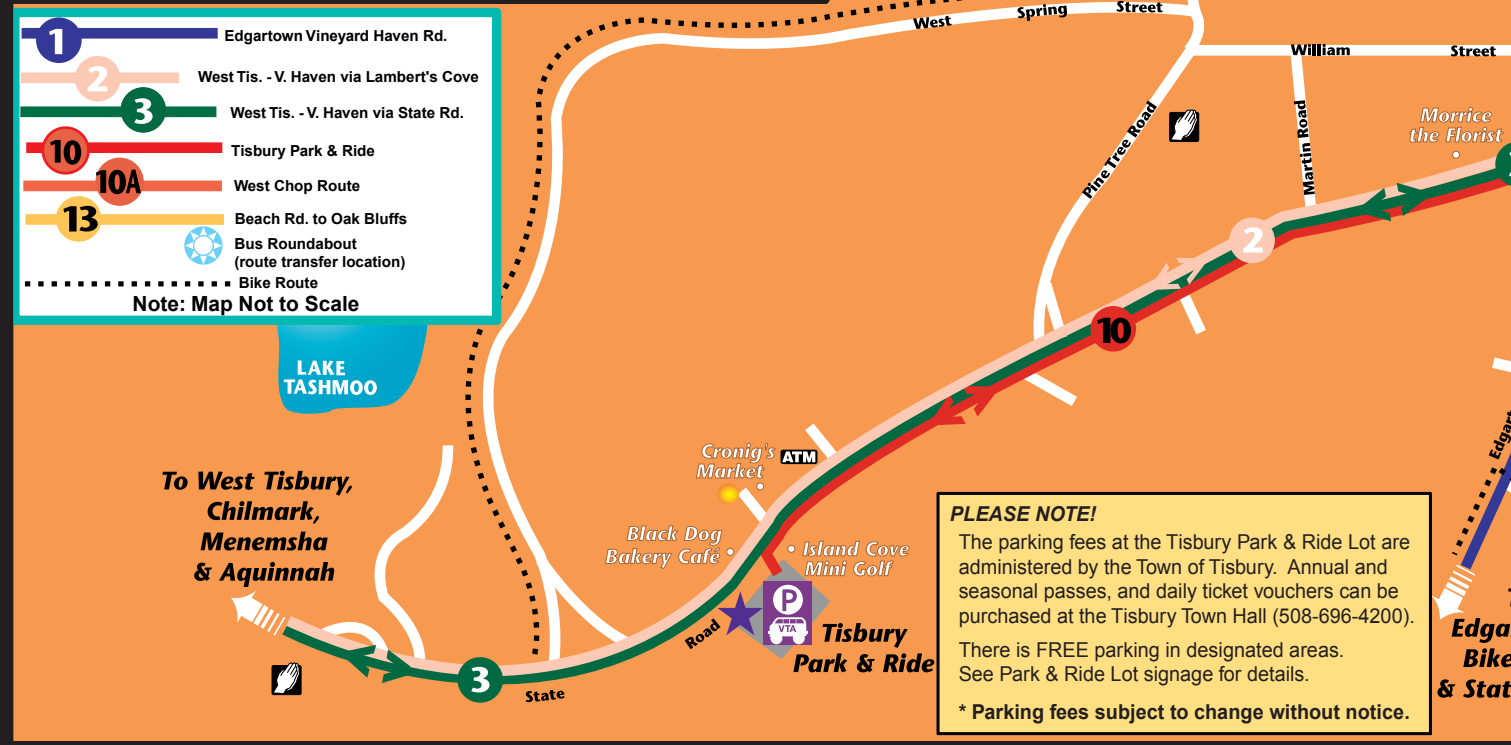
* Please note: The Tisbury Park-and-Ride is a single vehicle that serves both passengers going to departing ferries and passengers from arriving ferries. Read this timetable carefully and plan adequate time for transfers. Due to expected high traffic conditions, bus departures from the Park-and-Ride Lot are 30 minutes in advance of the 12:00 PM, 2:30 PM and 5:00 PM ferry departures.

Passes and Fares

VTA buses are equipped with electronic fareboxes. If you have a pass, swipe the magnetic stripe card through the slot in the top of the farebox and come aboard the bus. The VTA is not responsible for lost or stolen passes.

Before paying a one-way fare, please take a moment and consider buying an unlimited travel pass. Passes are the most cost-effective and easy way to ride the VTA. The 1-day, 3-day, and 7-day passes can be purchased right on the bus, at the Edgartown Visitors Center or the Steamship Authority terminals. Longer period passes are available for sale at the Edgartown Visitors Center or the VTA Operations Center in the Airport Business Park.

Exact fare is strongly suggested! Please do not ask the bus operator for change, as they are not permitted to handle fares.

No cash is returned from the farebox. Change is given in the form of stored value cards for future ride usage ONLY and are not redeemable for cash. No exceptions!

Fares and passes are non-refundable and non-transferable.

WHAT'S NEW THIS SEASON?

Regular and past riders of the VTA system will be familiar with the bus service this season, as it is similar to the level of service provided in past In-Seasons. However, there are a few changes to the schedule this year that should be noted below. These changes are being implemented to maintain and improve the quality transit service we strive to deliver to our customers.

Route #13 Shoulder Season Schedule

The so-called "shoulder seasons", before and after the busy peak summer months of July and August, are a wonderful time to be on the Island. On certain dates during the shoulder seasons, the VTA is increasing service during peak periods of the day to run on a frequency basis, rather than on a set schedule. Please read the timetable carefully as the schedule varies by date and day of the week during the shoulder seasons.

Route #1 Bus Stop Policy Change in Edgartown

To help maintain our schedule and trip times, the VTA will be phasing out flag stops on Route #1 in Edgartown only. The bus will stop at signed stops. In cooperation with the Town of Edgartown, additional paved pull-offs with signs and benches have been established to provide safe locations to board and disembark the bus. The rest of the transit system continues to be a flag stop system, with the exception of designated no-pickup zones.

New Timed Transfer Connection from Menemsha to Aquinnah

Check the Route #5 timetable for details on how to connect from Menemsha to Aquinnah directly during July and August using the Chilmark In-Town bus.

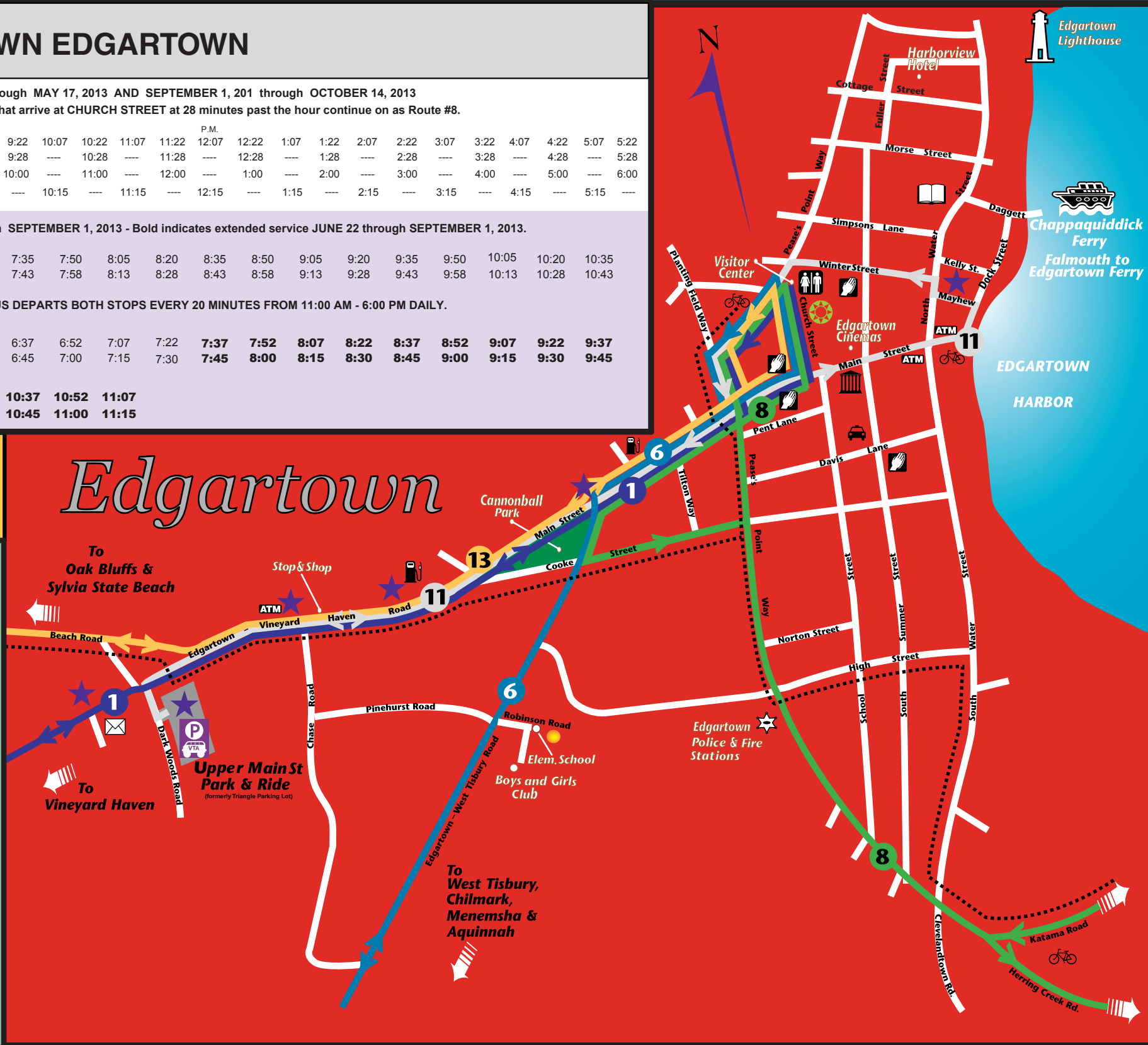

How to get there by VTA bus... A Town to Town Transit Guide

From TISBURY (VINEYARD HAVEN) to

- OAK BLUFFS: Route #13 - frequent service, check schedule for times.
- EDGARTOWN: Route #1 - see #1 schedule on reverse side. OR: Route #13 - see #13 schedule on reverse side.
- SOUTH BEACH: Option 1: Route #1 at :07 or :37 past to Church St., transfer to #8. Option 2: Route #13 (see #13 schedule on reverse), then #8.
- WEST TISBURY: Route #3 at :07 past to WT Business District and West Tisbury Town Hall. OR: Route #2 at :22 and :52 past every other hour.
- MENEMSHA: Route #3 at :07 past to West Tisbury Business District, arrive at :22 past, transfer to #4 at :33 past.
- AQUINNAH: Option 1: Route #3 at :07 past to West Tisbury Town Hall, arrive at :36 past, walk next door to Grange Hall stop for #5 at :38 past. Option 2: Route #2 at :22 and :52 past every other hour, transfer at West Tisbury Town Hall / Grange Hall to #5 at :38 past the hour. *Layover required

From OAK BLUFFS to

- EDGARTOWN: Route #13 from Ocean Park stop - check schedule for times.
- SOUTH BEACH: Route #13 from Ocean Park stop to Church Street in Edgartown, then take #8 - frequent service, check schedule for times.
- VINEYARD HAVEN: Route #13 from Steamship Authority Terminal side of Beach Road.
- WEST TISBURY: Option 1: Route #9 on the hour to MV Airport, arrive at :23 past, transfer to #6 at :25 past, arrive Grange Hall at :36 past. Option 2: Route #7 at :22 past to MV Airport, arrive at :51 past, wait to get on #6 at :25 past next hour to Grange Hall, WT. *Layover required
- MENEMSHA: Follow instructions to Grange Hall in West Tisbury, walk next door to West Tisbury Town Hall, catch #4 at :40 past.
- AQUINNAH: Option 1: Route #9 on the hour to MV Airport, arrive at :23 past, transfer to #6 at :25 past, stay on same bus for #5. Option 2: Route #7 at :22 past to MV Airport, arrive :51 past, wait to get on #6 at :25 past next hour, stay on same bus for #5. *Layover required

From EDGARTOWN to

- OAK BLUFFS: Route #13 - see yellow schedule on reverse side of map.
- VINEYARD HAVEN: Route #1 - see #1 schedule on reverse side. OR: Route #13 - see #13 schedule on reverse side.
- WEST TISBURY: Route #6 at :12 past to WT Grange Hall, arrive :36 past.
- MENEMSHA: Route #6 at :12 past to WT Grange Hall, arrive :36 past, walk next door to WT Town Hall, transfer to #4 at :40 past.
- AQUINNAH: Route #6 at :12 past to Grange Hall, stay on same bus for #5.

From WEST TISBURY to

- VINEYARD HAVEN: Route #2 or #3 from West Tisbury Town Hall.
- OAK BLUFFS: Option 1: Route #8 to West Tisbury Town Hall, transfer at MV Airport to #7. Option 2: Route #3 to Vineyard Haven or #6 to Edgartown, then transfer to #13.
- EDGARTOWN: Route #6 from West Tisbury Town Hall at :38 past.
- MENEMSHA: Route #4 from West Tisbury Town Hall at :40 past.
- AQUINNAH: Route #5 from Grange Hall at :38 past.

From CHILMARK and AQUINNAH to

- MENEMSHA: Transfer from Route #5 to Route #12 Chilmark In-Town bus at :25 past.
- AQUINNAH: Route #5 passes Chilmark Community Center at about :46 past.
- VINEYARD HAVEN: Route #4 or #5, transfer at West Tisbury Town Hall to #2 or #3.
- OAK BLUFFS: Option 1: Route #5 to West Tisbury Town Hall, stay on same bus for #3, transfer at VHS SSA Terminal to #13. Option 2: Route #4 or #5 to West Tisbury Town Hall, transfer to #6 at :38 past, transfer at MV Airport to #7 at :55 past.
- EDGARTOWN: Route #4 or #5 to West Tisbury Town Hall, then #6 at :38 past.
