Located on the harbor with the BEST view you can get from the expansive second-floor deck, you probably won't care what it costs as you gaze out at the breathtaking scenery. However, the prices are not to be ignored as they do not take advantage of you for wanting to enjoy some waterfront dining. Most sandwiches are in the 18-20 dollar range and are good size. One of the best deals we found on their menu is the Shanty Burger at just 16.99 for the base burger which in Edgartown is a good deal. Weighing in at a hefty half-pound of choice Angus Beef served with a generous portion of French Fries, this burger might be the cheapest on the island. You can add your favorite toppings such as cheese, Mushrooms, and Bacon for just \$2 each. Don't forget to get a basket of FREE popcorn on your way to your table but don't fill up because the food...and the view are worth the wait. Located at 30 dockside in Edgartown the Seafood Shanty is not hard to miss...just search out the best place to catch the view and you will find yourself sitting at a table, on a deck enjoying ..well..everything!
